




## 1983 and again 2018-2021

Anns early drawings often show a woman, who is wearing a hood. The married woman in Germany "unter der Haube" is well-behaved and characterized as orderly, domesticated—and boring. Without a hood, however, her hair is wild, represents freedom, creativity, and independence.





Anns approach alludes to Margaret Atwood's novel The Handmaid's Tale, in which the hood as the "uniform" of the "maid" expresses her suppression and exploitation.







My early drawings were not made for others but for me, to discover something and to say to myself: Here I am.
















Some of my hoods are surrounding a deep and black nothing. Nothing gives birth to everything.

















2019 HOOD, nickelsilver


