Looking back, I would like to honor this generation of mothers and their material.

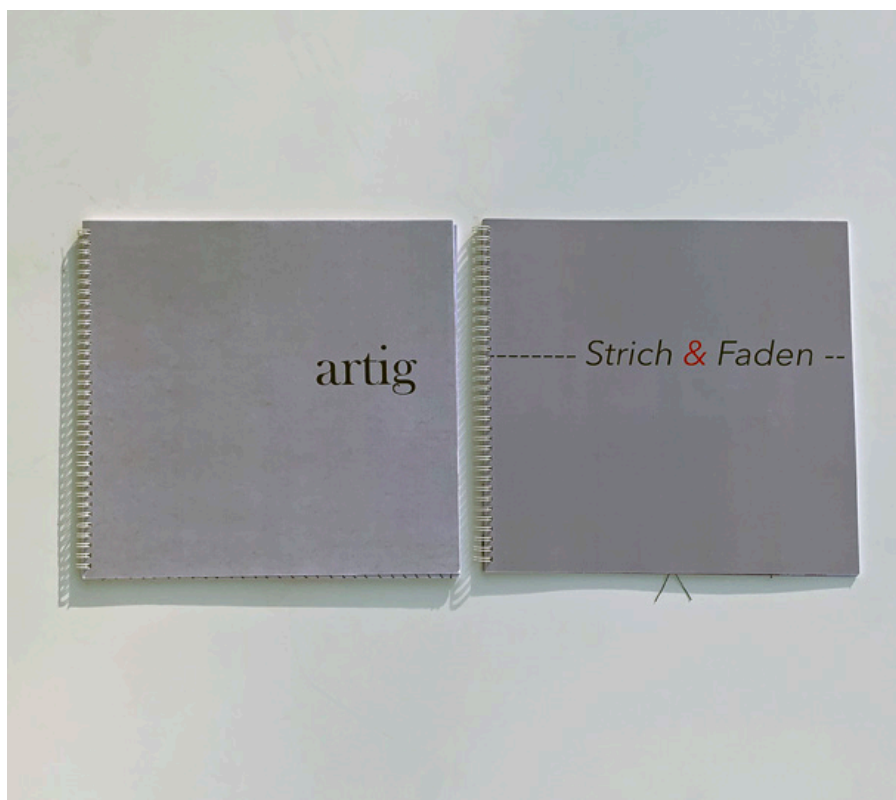


LIEBE MUTTI, pastel, 76 x 57 cm

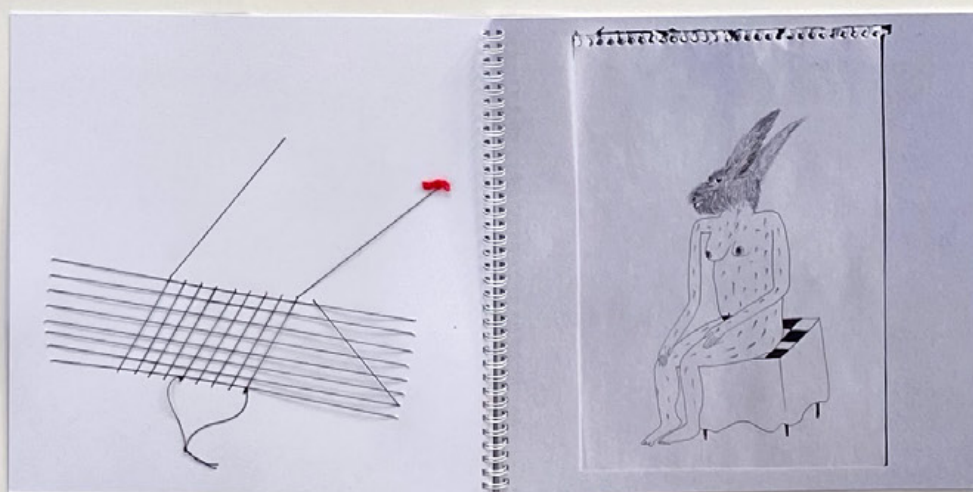
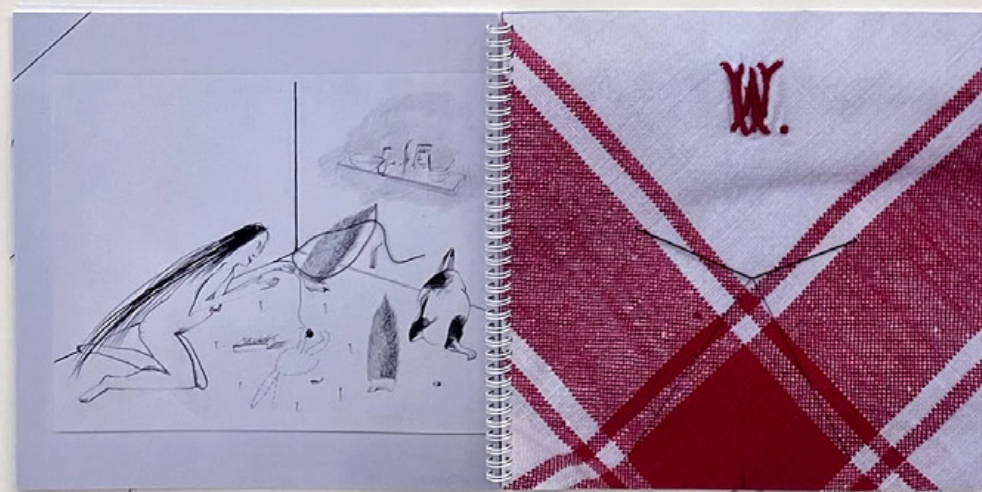
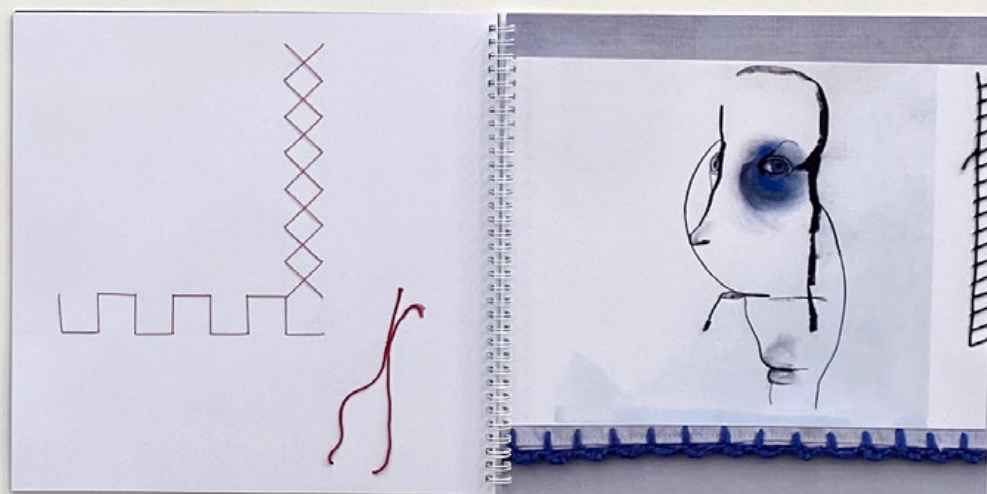
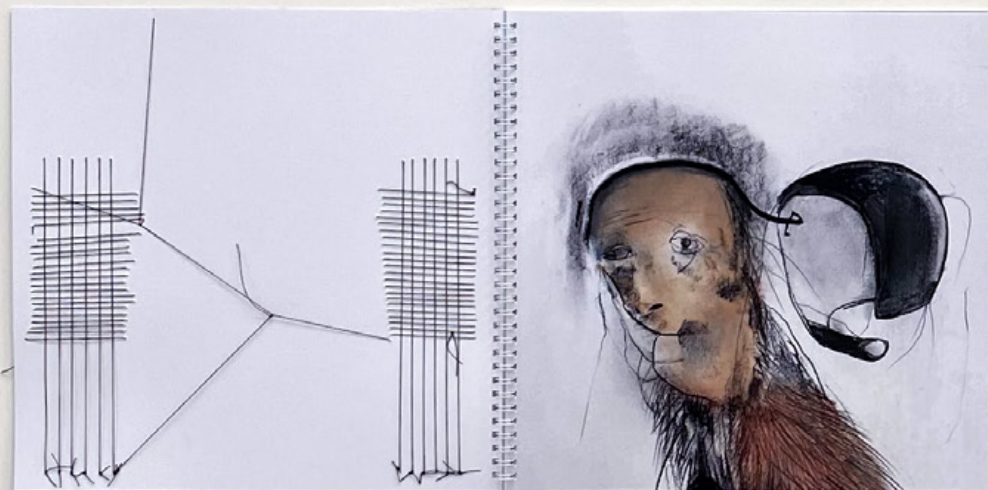
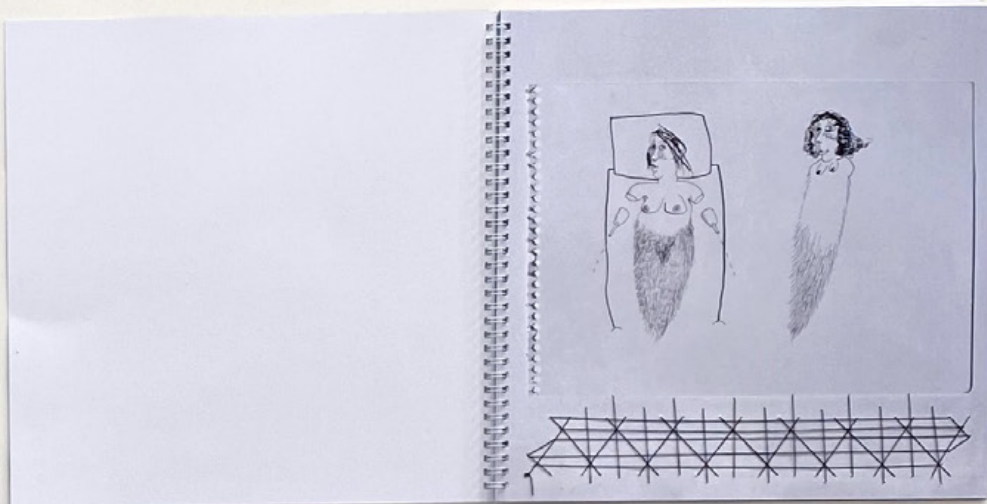
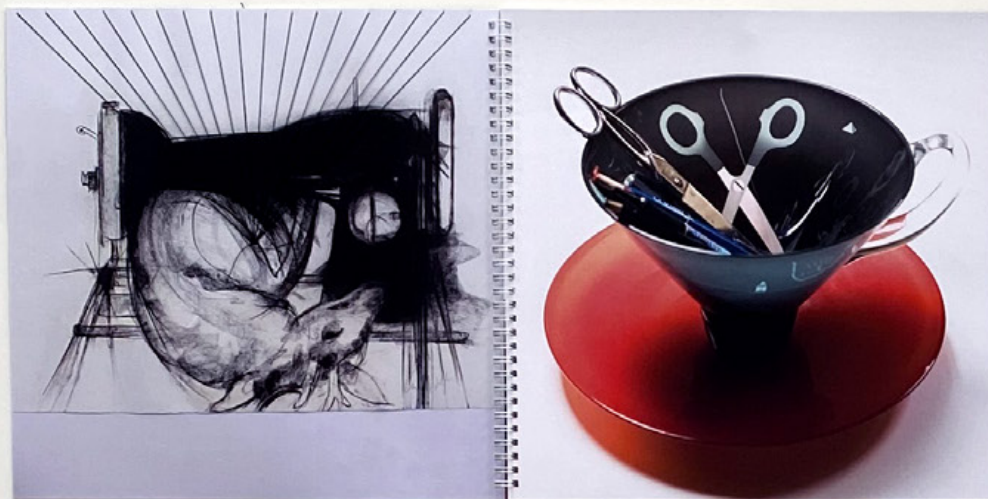
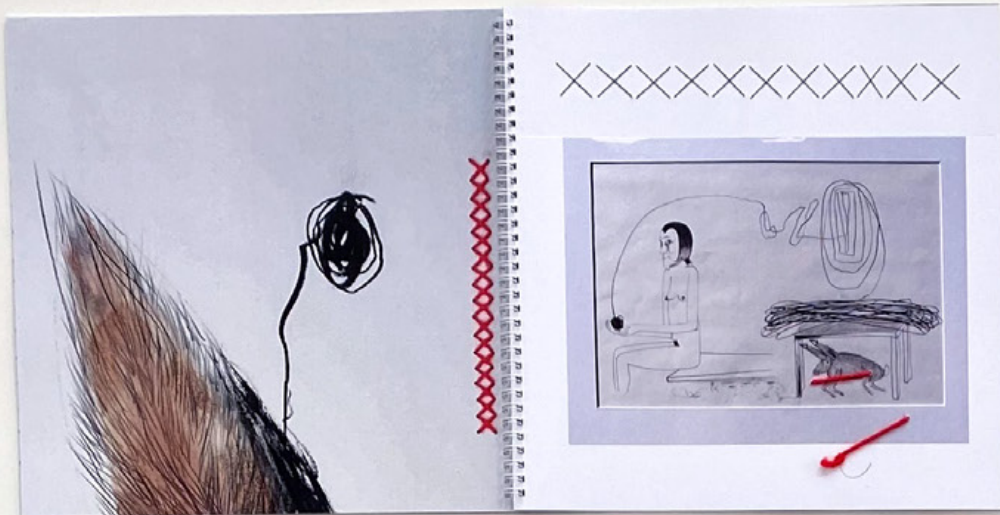

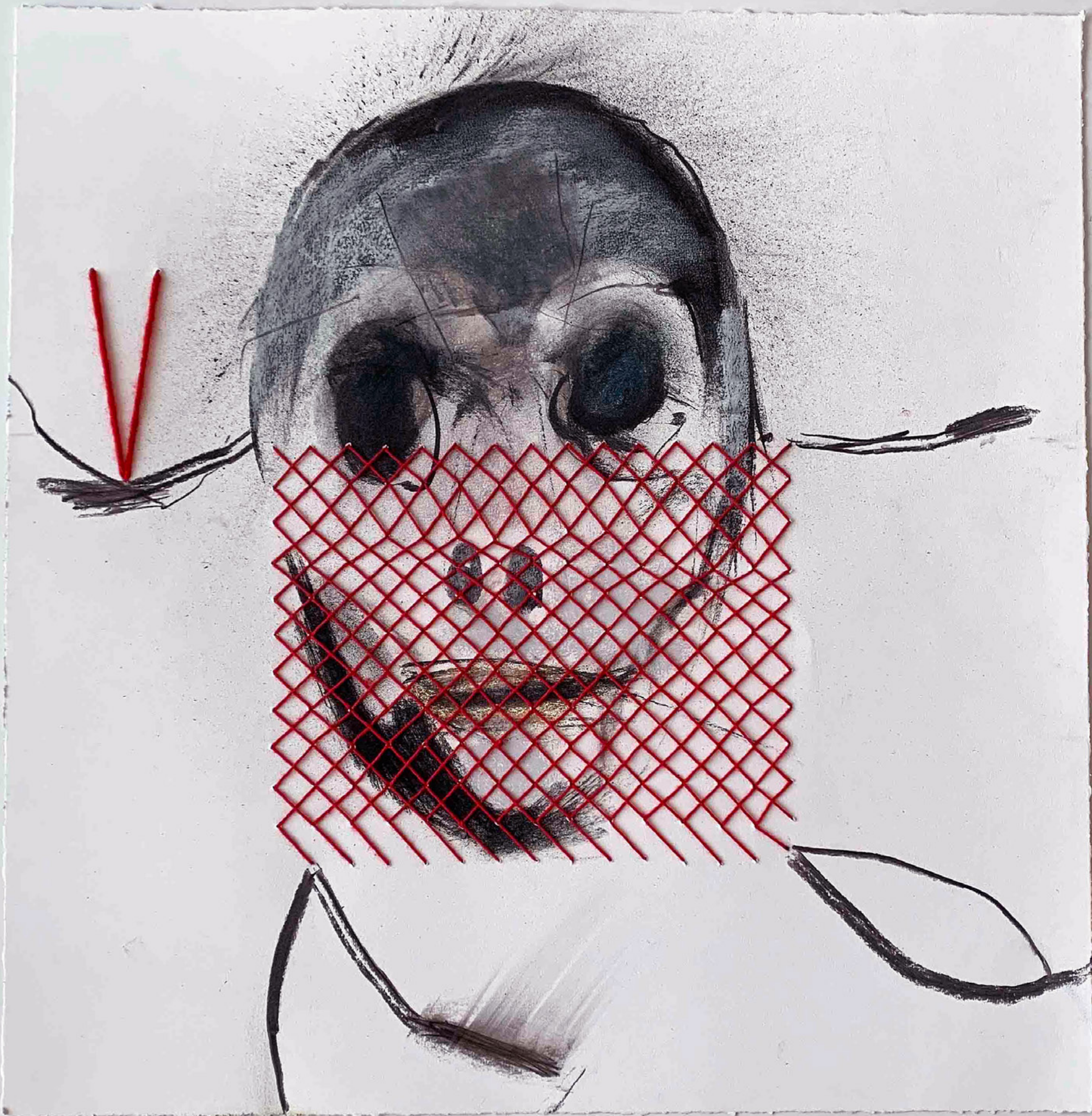




needlework and CEPHALOPODS

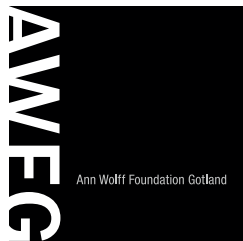
